

Notification of traffic changes: Kingsford

In planning for Tomorrow's Sydney we are building a new light rail line to provide modern, reliable and sustainable public transport that will transform services from Circular Quay and the CBD, to Kingsford and Randwick via Surry Hills, Moore Park and Kensington.

Standard work hours are Monday to Friday 6am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 5pm. This notification is for approved work that falls outside the standard working hours. This work will be carried out on the below dates and times to minimise disruption to traffic and to maintain the safety of construction work, residents, businesses and the general public.

Details of work activities

A temporary traffic change will move the light rail worksite to the median of Anzac Parade from **10pm Friday 2 June to 10pm Friday 14 July** to install light rail track at the following location:

- **Anzac Parade between Barker Street and Rainbow Street, Kingsford**

Night work will continue in the area for safety and traffic reasons. Work will include temporary relocation of the construction site, movement of barriers, line-marking, traffic signal adjustments and the establishment of new traffic arrangements.

Traffic and pedestrian changes

The following traffic and pedestrian changes will be in place:

- The light rail worksite will move to the median of Anzac Parade between Barker Street and Rainbow Street Kingsford.
- Traffic on Anzac Parade southbound will not be able to turn right into Strachan Street and Borrodale Road.
- Traffic on Anzac Parade northbound will not be able to turn right into Middle Street.
- Traffic on Anzac Parade will be able to turn left in/out of Strachan Street, Borrodale Road and Middle Street.
- Traffic on Strachan Street and Middle Street will be able to make east and west through movements and right turns onto Anzac Parade.
- The pedestrian crossings on Anzac Parade at Meeks Street and Borrodale Road will be re-opened.

Anzac Parade will remain open during all work and where possible two traffic lanes will be maintained in both directions. Construction speed limits may apply. Pedestrian footpaths will remain open.

Bus stops and services will not be impacted. Localised traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with the new traffic arrangements. Access to buildings will be maintained.

Please note waste collection will be unaffected by these works.

Please note that there will be further traffic changes on Anzac Parade after this notified period. When required, traffic management will assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists to move safely around the work. Impacted stakeholders will be notified in advance of any major changes to the traffic arrangement.
