

New carpark opens on Anzac Parade

Randwick City Council have built a new carpark on Anzac Parade and we're delighted to announce it's now open!

Randwick City Council have built a new car park on Anzac Parade, between Sturt Street and Botany Street and we hope you are able to utilise this when you visit our club. Parking in and around the Juniors has long been an issue for club members particularly as over 80% of our members drive to the club. We are aware of this issue and have been working hard to identify alternative parking options. In addition to the new carpark built by Randwick City Council, members can park at the fruit market site (even though some of this car park is used for storing rail and track equipment) or the car park located underneath the Juniors which you can access from the southbound carriageway of Anzac Parade. Our courtesy bus operates 7 days (after 5pm) a week with free pickups from your home.

In the longer term, Randwick City Council are looking at building a multi storey carpark on a site nearby in the future. Finally, management at the Juniors are also looking at providing car parking for staff at a location nearby and providing a shuttle bus service to the club for these staff so as to free up car parking spaces around the Juniors for our members.
